Trinity County Board of Supervisors,

The Trinity County Collaborative Group (TCCG) is working to better understand the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the ability of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest to comply with NEPA regulations. Our interest is focused on the Forest's ability to have a record of decision completed for projects, and how that compares to other forests in Region 5 and Region 6.

The Trinity County Collaborative Group (TCCG) has formally voted on and approved the following:

The TCCG formally requests that the United States Forest Service (USFS) present to the TCCG a ranking of relevant metrics such as signed records of decisions, litigation outcomes, etc, which show results of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest planning process. We realize this may be a Freedom of Information Act request, but would like to make the request informally first.

The Trinity County Collaborative Group asks that the Trinity County Board of Supervisors work with the USFS for the information discussed above to help us better understand NEPA and the NEPA process.
